DIRECTIONS TO KAVINGA SAFARI CAMP FROM HARARE

- From Harare, drive approximately **296km** on the main Chirundu highway to Makuti.
- **15km** beyond Makuti, stop in at the National Parks' office at Marongora and fill in your National Parks Entry Permit. Advise them that you will be staying at Kavinga Safari Camp.
- Drive a further **6.5km** past Marongora - a gravel road turns to the right (just after the Tsetse Fly Control hut/boom). This is the first National Parks boom, commonly called Chimutsi Gate and it is the entrance to Mana Pools. Turn in to the right, submit your permit to the ranger for verification at the boom, fill in the Parks Register for Kavinga.
- Pass through the boom and continue along this first dirt road for approximately **25.2km** until you see our Kavinga Safari Camp sign and a turning to your right. GPS co-ordinates for this turnoff are : S16°05.575'05 E29°22.121'04.
- Take this right turn at our sign and follow our subsequent signs for roughly another **4.8km** directly to camp. Our staff will be waiting to greet you.
- For those of you using a GPS, camp co-ordinates are: 16°07'05.20" S 29°24'06.55" E.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- There are two toll gates along this main road, please be sure to have either some Zimbabwe bond cash notes with you, US Dollars cash in small denominations or some form of local electronic payment available.
- Be prepared for possibly encountering police roadblocks along your journey. We suggest checking the Dear ZRP and Road Users Association Facebook pages to ensure that your vehicle is compliant with gazetted regulations.
- A recommended stopping place along the way is Saucy Sue's at Lion's Den. They serve great egg & bacon and steak rolls, sell biltong, snacks, drinks and interesting wooden items such as picture frames and cutting boards, as well as providing clean ablutions.
- You will not need to show any documentation for your stay at Kavinga and you will not be required to pay any National Parks fees at Marongora. The Parks rangers are aware that Kavinga settles all National Parks fees payments directly with Parks on their guests' behalf.
- Please note that, when leaving the Park and handing over your Parks permit to the first Parks boom, you will not need to show them a Parks receipt for your stay at Kavinga.
- Persons travelling to Mana Pools must leave Marongora no later than 3.30pm.
- Please be aware that the gravel road past Chimutsi boom can be very corrugated and due care must be taken. In some stretches it may be best to travel at only 15 or 20 km/hour.
- The journey generally takes about 5hr30min, depending upon your speed, stops and traffic.
